Approved Kindergarten Program Providers

As an approved provider, this service holds a current Queensland service approval for a centre based service, under the Education and Care Services National Law (National Law) or the Education and Care Services Act 2013, and an appropriate public liability insurance of at least \$10 million. To be eligible to receive funding the service must provide a kindergarten program:

- To children who are at least 4 years of age by 30 June in their kindergarten year
- Delivered by a qualified early childhood teacher
- Aligned with the Queensland Kindergarten Learning Guideline, or other education program approved by the Queensland Curriculum and Assessment Authority
- For at least 15 hours a week, 40 weeks a year or a minimum of 600 hours over 37 weeks for services operated by non-state

ABSENCES FROM KINDY

Fees are non-refundable for missed sessions; however if a vacancy is available you may make up time on a Make-up Day. This is a gesture of goodwill by the Committee, an opportunity not offered by most services. With the kindy only operating three days per week, staff will try to accommodate make up sessions with the co-operation of all families. If your child is to be away, from sickness or special family circumstances, please phone the kindy and your child's place can be offered to another child as a make-up day. To arrange a makeup day please ask staff to include you in the kindy Make up day Register, and a place will be offered, when available and according to the register. Days must be taken in the term that they were missed and will not be carried over into subsequent terms.

CHANGE OF ATTENDANCE OR CANCELLATION OF ENROLMENT

Parents/Carers are required to give staff 2 weeks' written notice for cancellation of enrolment, or permanent changes to attendance. If appropriate notice is given, a pro-rata rate of fees paid may be reimbursed, depending on the amount of time remaining in a term.

| Subsidised fees | \$13.50 per day | Families with a Health Care card, pension card or who identify as ATSI are entitled to a low-cost kindergarten at a reduced daily rate, applicable to pre-prep children. |
| Mowing/ consumables levy | \$40 per year | This levy is used for paying for mowing of the grounds and purchasing items such as copy paper and tissues. This levy will be added to Term 1 fees |
| Fund-raising levy | \$50 per semester | Families will have the option to: a) Participate in fundraising for one event per term or: b) Pay the fundraising levy. This levy will be added to the term 2 and 4 invoices if the families have not participated in fundraising throughout the year. |

Participation can include either:

- Donating your time, working at events or market stalls.
 - Donating items for events, for example, food for catering (cakes, slices, deserts) or donating items for raffles.
 - Mowing the kindy grounds once per term.
 - Selling raffle tickets to the public/helping with pub raffles
- The fundraising levy will assist the Kindergarten to more efficiently fundraise within the community.

PAYMENTS

Accounts will be issued for each term, and can be paid in full or in regular instalments, by arrangement. We prefer that accounts are paid into the Kindergarten bank account via direct debit. Invoices are sent home / emailed during the second week of each term and fees must be paid in full by the end of week 4, each term.
